Provisions for Deposits according to RA 5.8.1
Environmental regulations for service in contest / training
The service teams of the individual competitor / team shall be equipped and serviced as follows: (G2.4)

- Sealed tarpaulin, or equivalent protection, should always be used under a race car when servicing the car, regardless of ground cover. The protection should be so big that it also protects against larger leakage, thus significantly larger than the actual racing vehicle. Any leakage on the guard must not be flushed by the protection other than at the designated location of the organizer.

- collection containers should be available for collecting liquids. It shall hold at least 1½ times the amount of liquids (excluding fuel) contained in the race car, but at least 10 liters.

Responsibility

Participation in the competition takes place at the competitor's own risk. Affected International Federation (FIA, CIK, EFRA, IFMAR) The Swedish Association, Svenska Bilportförbundet (SBF), Specialsport Districts Federation (SDF), organizer or including staff at the time can not be held responsible for personal injury or property damage that may occur during the competition. Any claims claiming against the organizer may be transferred directly to individual participant.

Personal data

Competition participants and officers have, through their registration, participated in the competition, agreed that their personal data are recorded in the competition organizer's data register and that, in the course of their activities, the organizer publishes the name information regardless of the media.
